The Europa Cantat 2021 festival in Ljubljana will gather choir enthusiasts from all over the world and offer a variety of educational content, numerous concerts along with many other interesting events. The photo exhibition, which will take place from 1 July to 1 August 2021, will undoubtedly be one of them.



WHAT:

Photo exhibition

WHERE:

Ljubljana, Tivoli Park, the Jakopič Promenade

EXHIBITION TIMELINE:

1 July-1 August 2021

NUMBER OF BOARDS:

80

The exhibition will be displayed on the illuminated boards running along the Jakopič Promenade in Park Tivoli, Ljubljana's central park. Its aim is to emphasise the presence of the Europa Cantat festival in Ljubljana, bring the choral activity closer to the general public through a visual perspective, and encourage singing groups to create more imaginative choral photographs. The open call is international and anyone wishing to send a choral photograph that meets other conditions is invited to participate.

PHOTO CONTENT:



- Artistic and situational photographs related to choral activity;
- The most original, creative and imaginative photographs will be considered.

CATEGEORIES:



1. PAST/RETRO/VINTAGE

Looking for records of choral history:

- 1A: First examples of choral photography;
- 1B: Choirs and their "outfits" in the past: concert clothing, hairstyles, customs, practices, etc.;
- 1C: Contemporary retro-style photography.

2. ON THE STAGE

Looking for surpluses:

- Choral panoramas: special scenography, lighting, costumes, choreographies, and staging;
- Emotions on stage: physical and facial expressions (not necessarily of the entire group, details);
- Visually representative portraits.

3. BACKSTAGE

Looking for narrative, meaningful, picturesque, attractive and unusual moments:

- Preparation;
- Emotions after a performance or competition;
- Social aspect.

4. PROMO

- Attractive, original, thoughtful promotional photographs of choirs that inspire others to take more visually interesting approaches;
- Interactions of a choir with its cultural environment, important historical and tourist points.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR A PHOTOGRAPH



- Photographs are acceptable in colour or black and white;
- Minimal corrections are allowed (colour and tone correction, crop);
- Author or photograph holder/owner;
- Photographs must be sent in a JPG format with a

resolution of 300 dpi, a size of at least 3,000 x 2,000 pixels (landscape orientation), and a size of individual file up to approximately 10 MB.

• Display board size: 185 x 125 (visual field – 180 x 120) 180 x 20 – accompanying text





TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION



- The author/applicant can send a maximum of 4 photographs for each category.
- The author/applicant shall not receive a fee for the exhibited photograph.
- The applicant must have obtained a publication permission of the persons on the photograph which is not historical or taken during a public event. The organisers take no responsibility for publishing photographs of persons who have not granted permission for it.
- By applying for the exhibition, the applicant declares authorship.
- If the applicant in the categories 1C, 2, 3 and 4 is not the author of the photograph, the applicant must obtain the author's written consent and consent for participation in the photo exhibition that also gives the organiser the right to use the photographs under the terms of the open call.

- By applying, the author/applicant accepts the conditions of the open call.
- The jury of JSKD will decide on the suitability of the submitted photographs and make the final selection for the exhibition.
- A maximum of 80 photographs will be selected and exhibited.
- The official opening of the exhibition will take place on 1 July 2021 at the Jakopič Promenade in Tivoli Park and will run until 1 August 2021.
- The organiser may use the submitted works to promote this open call in media for noncommercial purposes without having to pay a fee. If the author disagrees with this, their decision can be indicated on the application form.

APPLICATION



The application is possible via the online application form on this <u>link</u>.

Application details:

- Name and surname
- Contact details (e-mail, telephone, address)
- Name and surname of the author of the photograph
- Official name of the choir in the photograph
- Country (of the applicant)
- The year the photograph was taken
- Description of the photograph up to 300 characters with spaces
- I, the applicant (if I am not the author of the submitted photograph), have the author's written consent for participating in the call.
- I, the applicant, have obtained a permission of the persons on the photograph, which is not historical or taken during a public event (categories 1A, 1B and 3).
- By applying, I accept the terms of the open call.
- I allow a non-paid publication for the purpose of promoting the Choral Photo Promenade.

File naming:

• applicant_category_title of the photograph The title of the photograph must match the information on the application form.

The deadline for applying and submitting the photographs is Monday, 19 April 2021.

Participation in the call means that the author accepts the rules set by the organiser. By submitting the application form, the applicant accepts the provisions of the open call.
